People speaking at the Open Forum may present information to the Governing Council, but the Open Forum will include no Council actions or discussions. Individuals who wish to speak for longer than three minutes or who require Council discussion or action must use the procedure in A.15 to be placed on the Council agenda. Complaints about individual employees will not be heard at Council meetings.
